

LEGAL BASES

FREAK PAINTING WARS 2020

This contest is organized by **LA POSADA DEL FRIKI**, non-profit association, and organizer of Freak Wars; with the sponsorship of **Corvus Belli, ImpriWars, Hera Models, Scale75, Big Child, Euromodelismo, Landscapes in Detail, Vallejo, Miniaturas Magerit Siglo XXI, Scale Model Challenge (SMC), Model34, Arrimodels and Todoart/Roubloff** during the days planned for the annual event **FREAK WARS 2020** held this year in Online format from September 11 to 13, 2020. The contest is aimed at painting works.

1. Form of participation

The delivery of paint works will be done **digitally through the website of Freak Wars** in the following [web form](#), under the established conditions in the present bases of participation.

- a) **Any number of works per participant can be submitted through the official web of Freak Wars, with the deadline being Sunday, September 6th at 23:59 (GMT+2).**
- b) **The inscription is free.**
- c) For the presentation of the works, **3 photographs in good quality must be taken of each work from the following angles** in order to make a correct evaluation: **front and both sides**. A fourth optional photo could be uploaded, and it may be a different view (e.g.: back of the miniature) or a photo composition that shows a set of details of the miniature.
- d) Judges, members of the Freak Wars organization, as well as sponsoring brands are excluded from the contest. **Volunteers from Freak Wars**, not being part of the organization, **are allowed to participate**.
- e) The works can be shown in social media by the organization and the press media present at the event.

- f) The works can be reassigned by the jury to the category they consider appropriate.

2. Categories

The **Freak Painting Wars contest** has two modalities:

- **Standard:** For the general public over 14 years. The submitted works will be eligible for the "Best of Show" award.
 - **Individual miniature of less of 40mm:** Single miniature with scenic base smaller than 40mm.
 - **Individual miniature of 40mm or greater:** Single miniature with scenic base of 40mm or greater.
 - **Bust:** Bust of any size.
 - **Vehicle, war machine or monster:** Any type of vehicle, bipod, war machine, monstrous creature (giants, dragons, etc.), ships, planes, tanks, etc.
 - **Unit or band:** Set of a minimum of three miniatures of any scale that comprise a unit or band in context on individual or shared scenic bases with up to a maximum of 12 miniatures.
 - **Diorama:** Scenic representation of a scene using miniatures of any scale.
 - **Event miniature:** Individual miniature. Any of the miniatures of the event of previous editions will be valid. You can find the miniatures of the event here: <https://www.hungry-troll.com/freak-wars>. This year's (Crab Samurai) is not included for the contest.

- **Master:** This modality focuses on a professional audience with which to demonstrate the techniques and skills dominated by the artist. The submitted works will be eligible for the "Best of Show" award.
 - **54mm or less:** Creation carried out with one or more miniatures of **54mm or less**.
 - **More than 54mm:** Creation carried out with one or more miniatures of **more than 54mm**.
 - **Bust:** Individual bust of any scale.
 - **Open:** One or more miniatures of any scale that complete a scene, a diorama, a monster, a war machine, form a unit or do not fit in the rest of the categories.

- **Special Categories:** This modality focuses on any work presented on the following topics:
 - **Hera Models Award:** Any model from Hera Models brand.

3. Awards

- a) In a first phase, a selection of the most voted works on the Freak Wars website will be made. These works will be the finalists of the competition and will go on to the next phase, in which they will be evaluated by the jury.
- b) The jury will assess each work and make the decision as a whole, assessing the aspects that they consider most important, but always keeping the painting as the main value.
- c) The awards ceremony will take place on Sunday September 13 at 17:00 during the live broadcast of Freak Wars 2020 Online.
- d) The prizes to be awarded according to each category will be the following:

3.1 Standard:

- Badges will be awarded (this year as a digital diploma) for the Gold, Silver and Bronze prizes.
- The prizes will have an "Open" format: As many gold, silver and bronze as the jury will be awarded, there may be several prizes of each type.
- Honorable mentions, called "Dragon's Fangs" (this year as a digital diploma), will also be given to exceptional works. Those awarded with these mentions may not be presented the following year to any "Standard" category, being limited to the "Master" categories.
- Raffle of products and/or store vouchers from different brands collaborating with Freak Wars among all participants in the "Standard" categories (excluding the winner of the BoS) who have not submitted any work in any "Master" category. The prizes will be raffled by the organization during the weekend of the event. A single participant may not receive more than one single prize. Each eligible participant occurs only one entry in the raffle,

regardless of the number of works submitted. The prizes to be raffled are the following:

- **Corvus Belli:** 120€ voucher for online store (Partner figures excluded)
- **Scale75:** 100€ voucher for online store
- **Big Child Creatives:** 50€ voucher for online store
- **ImpriWars:** M-size figure carrying case with engraved Freak Wars logo, and methacrylate door
- **Landscape in Detail:** 60€ voucher for online store
- **Vallejo:** Two prizes, each with 2 packs of paintings to choose
- **Miniaturas Magerit Siglo XXI:** 40€ voucher for online store
- **Hera Models:** 25€ voucher for online store
- **Arrimodels:** 45€ voucher for online store
- **Todoart/Roubloff:** Two prizes, each one a 25€ voucher for online store

3.2 Master:

- Venerable Dragon Trophy for each category in gold, silver and bronze. The trophy will be sent to the winners. After the event, the winners will be contacted to send them their prize.

3.3 Special Categories:

- For the special category of **Hera Models**, an **exclusive trophy** of the brand itself, and a **50€ voucher** for their online store will be awarded. The winning work will be chosen by a person in charge of Hera Models, among all those presented in this category.

3.4 Best of Show (BoS):

- The best work from Standard and Master.
- This prize will be unique.
- The winning work will not win any other prize.
- Possibility of being jury the following year.
- Platinum Venerable Dragon Trophy and a 200€ check that will be delivered by bank transfer. The trophy will be sent to the winner. After the event, the winners will be contacted to send them their prize.

3.5 Special Award Scale Model Challenge (SMC):

- On the occasion of the collaboration between events in the sector, the organizers of the Scale Model Challenge (SMC) event, which is held every year in Veldhoven, the Netherlands, will grant a special award to a work chosen from among all those submitted to the contest.

3.6 Special Award Model34:

- On the occasion of the collaboration between sector events, the Model34 association, organizers of the “Ciudad de Leganés” Static Modeling Contest, which is held every year in Madrid, Spain, will grant a special prize to a work chosen from among all those submitted to the contest .

4. Jury

- a) The jury of Freak Painting Wars of Freak Wars 2020 will be formed by the following members, all of them of great recognition in the sector.

- b) The decision of the jury will be irrevocable.

5. Fraud

- a) The organization reserves the right to exclude any participant from the present contest if there is any indication of fraud.
- b) Likewise, the organization reserves the right to withdraw the participation of any contestant in the case of writing or making inappropriate comments prior or during the event.
- c) Those participants who use false profiles, false data or other fraud mechanisms to participate in this contest will also be eliminated from the contest.
- d) The organization reserves the right to request ID, passport or driver's license to prove the identity of the participants.

6. Causes of force majeure

- a) The organization reserves the right to cancel the contest, when causes of force majeure occur that so require, without it being the object of claims of any kind.

7. Modification of the legal bases

- a) The organization reserves the right to make, at any time, any modifications, deletions and/or additions to these legal bases.

8. Acceptance of the present rules and legal bases

- a) The simple act of participating implies full acceptance of these rules and legal bases, leaving the jury entitled to resolve any eventuality not foreseen.
